Cast molten salvaged bottle glass into thick walled 4ft. diameter deep focus paraboloids using concentrically nested parabolic stone crucibles; \* SOLAR HEATED \* by a giant parabolic mirror surfaced solar concentrator the size of a radio telescope, or outdoor stadium ... yielding more then twice the power of the Odeillo solar furnace.

The glass paraboloids would be more durable, useful and multi-purposed then the old style Coca Cola bottle from "The gods Must Be Crazy!" ...
