## Video Setup Guide

### For connecting iOS (iPhone) camera to macOS (Mac) with EpocCam

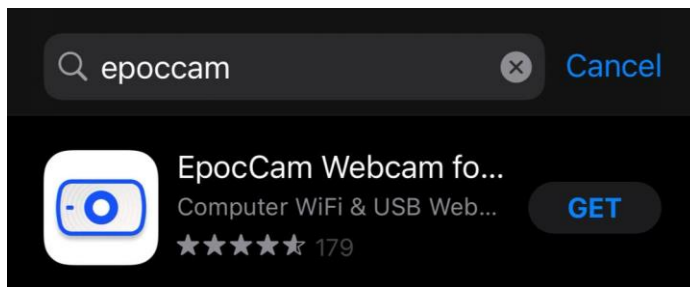
**Introduction:** This is a video setup guide for recording a video from iOS (iPhone) mobile device's camera to macOS (Mac) by using EpocCam application.

#### Step 1. Download the software for macOS.

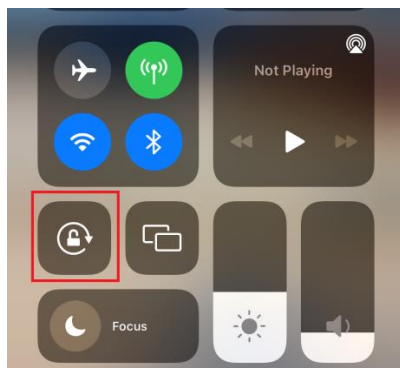
- Download the Camera Hub software from this link:  
<https://www.elgato.com/en/downloads>
- Double click on the downloaded setup file and follow the instructions.
- Start the Camera Hub application on your computer.

#### Step 2. Install the software for iOS mobile device.

- Go to App Store on your mobile device and search “EpocCam”.
- Click the “Get” button if you see the EpocCam application logo as displayed below.



- Open EpocCam application once it is installed and grant the permissions.
- Make sure the restricted rotation option is off on your smartphone.

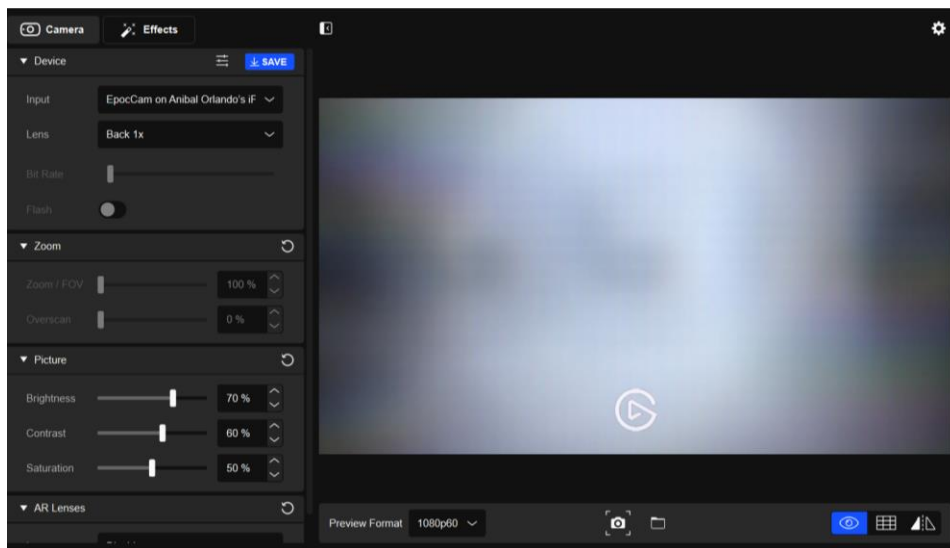


### Step 3.1. Connect by USB

- Connect your mobile device to the PC with a USB cable.
- Once the app is open on the phone screen, the USB will automatically recognize the PC and connect to the app you installed on Windows.
- You are now connected and ready for recording your video.

### Step 3.2. Connect by Wi-Fi

- Make sure your computer and your mobile device are connected to the same Wi-Fi network.
- Open the application on your mobile phone and macOS software on your computer.
- The application on the mobile device will automatically detect your computer and give you the option to connect.
- You are now connected and ready for recording your video.
- For recording the video, you can select QuickTime Player or Zoom software. Review the guides below.



### Step 4.1. Record the video with QuickTime Player

Using Screenshot in the QuickTime Player app, you can make a video recording of your computer screen. You can open the recording in the app and save it on your Mac.

- In the QuickTime Player app on your Mac, choose File > New Screen Recording (Figure 3) to open Screenshot and display the tools. You can click Options to control what you record — for example, you can set the

location where you want to save your screen recording or include the pointer or clicks in the screen recording (Figure 4).

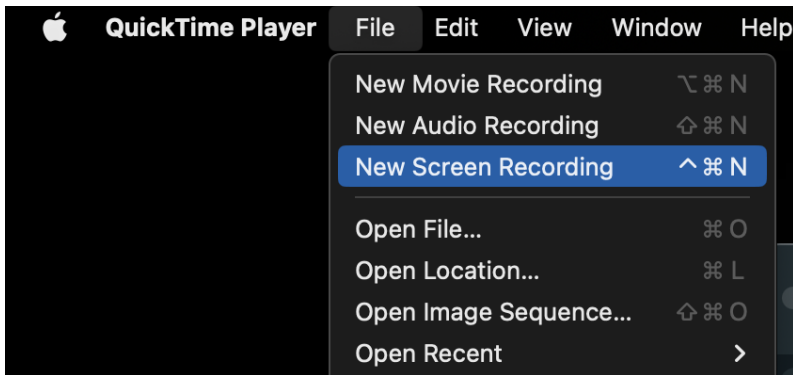

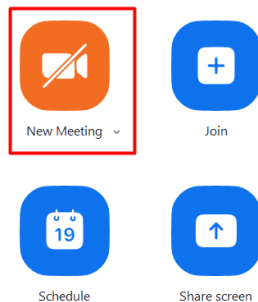

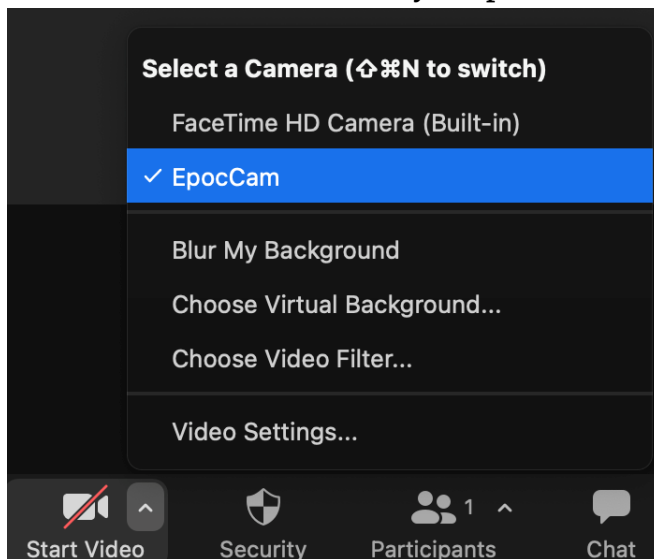
- Click Record. To stop recording, click the Stop Recording button  in the menu bar (or use the Touch Bar). Depending on where you chose to save the recording, an app may open.

#### Step 4.2. Record the Video with Zoom

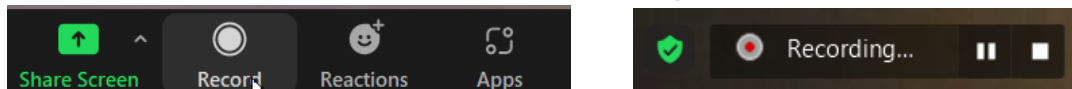
- Download Zoom software from [this link](#) to your PC.
- Install the application by double-clicking on it and following the instructions on the screen.
- Sign in to Zoom and start a new meeting.



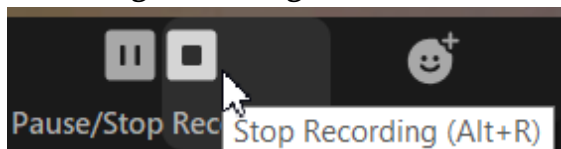
- Go to video settings by clicking on the arrow on the camera icon and select “EpoCam” and enable the video by clicking on the camera icon. Now you will be able to see the view from your phone screen on the Zoom call.



- Click on the “Record” button to start recording.



- Click on the “Stop” button to stop the recording. Please note that all Zoom recordings are being saved to \Documents\Zoom on Mac.



- Your video is now ready for being uploaded.
